## **Electronic Fund Transfers (ACH) for monthly membership fees**

Dear students, we have made an arrangement with Banknorth that allows us to do electronic fund transfers. This program allows Aikido of Champlaine Valley to receive monthly membership dues electronically, from your bank account directly to our bank account. As of January 1<sup>st</sup>, 2009, dues will go up by \$10, and the late fee will be \$15 for dues not paid by the 10<sup>th</sup> of the month. All students who participate in this program will receive a \$10 discount off monthly membership dues, and you won't have to pay late fees again.

You may cancel or change the ACH agreement at any time, either in person or by completing a dojo exit form explaining why you want to leave the dojo, take a temporary leave of absence, and/ or change the amount deducted. This attachment also contains the actual ACH form. Please do not return the form by e-mail because we have not established a secure system for on-line transactions; instead, mail or bring the form to the dojo. We prefer if you do this for November dues – if you have already paid your dues for November, please consider joining the program for December.

The ACH program is also a convenient way to support the Youth At Risk Aikido Program. You can make donations every month in order to support children who cannot afford aikido. Donations are tax-exempt. Please let us know if you need the ein # of Aikido of Champlaine Valley in order to make a tax exempt donation.
